



### Family/Staff Information Form

In order for the individual to be able to participate as an “Inclusion Athlete” in an upcoming RACIN! event, family/staff must adhere to the following....

1. Family/Staff must meet the RACIN! Team one hour prior to the start of the race to help with transfer of the individual into the racing chair, and be at the finish line at the end of the race to resume supervision and assist with transfer out of the chair. The RACIN! Push Team will NOT be responsible for supervision prior to or after the race.
2. If the individual has a specific Behavior Plan or certain health considerations that require specific supervision/monitoring/training, those trained family/staff members must provide supervision to the individual at all times throughout the course of the event (i.e., prior to the race, during the race by following alongside the racing chair, after the race has ended).
3. The “Inclusion Athlete Liability Form” must be completed (either by the individual or his/her guardian) and handed to the RACIN! Race Captain prior to the race for the person to be pushed in the racing chair.
4. If family/staff want to be members of the “push team,” the “Push Team Liability Form” must be completed and handed to the Race Captain prior to the race.
5. Family/Staff must provide RACIN! with a contact number in case of an emergency. This number should be written on the “Inclusion Athlete Liability Form.”

If any of the aforementioned rules are not followed, the RACIN! Team retains the right to disapprove of the person’s involvement in the RACIN! event at their discretion.
